## The Play

When fraternal twins Viola and Sebastian are separated in a shipwreck, Viola assumes that Sebastian is dead. Viola disguises herself as a boy and woos Olivia for her master, Duke Orsino, whom Viola loves. But Olivia falls in love with the disguised Viola instead. Meanwhile, Olivia's gluttonous relative, Sir Toby Belch, and his companions, pull a practical joke on the priggish Malvolio, Olivia's steward, who then acts so peculiarly that he is confined to a mental institution. Nothing is what it seems, and confusion reigns until the very last moment!
