THE MOUNTAINEERS FOUNDATION

Early last year The Mountaineers transferred all except 20 acres of the 200 acre Rhododendron Preserve to The Mountaineers Foundation. The Forest Theatre and Kitsap Cabin are situated on the 20 acres retained by The Mountaineers. The property was transferred to better protect it. especially by purchasing buffer properties around the borders. Last year an adjacent five acre parcel straddling Chico Creek, a short distance downstream from the theater, was purchased. This year the Foundation has make the initial payment on a parcel many of you are familiar with because your car is parked there. The Foundation has purchased it as a buffer to protect the Preserve from development on its very borders with the potential for damage to the wilderness we are trying to protect. Other properties are also available if we have the money to purchase them. If you would like to help us protect this unique wilderness area, your contribution is still tax exempt if you itemize. In appreciation for contributions received today, everyone contributing five dollars or more will receive a packet of handsome note cards with illustrations from the book "Northwest Trees" by Stephen Arno and Ramona Hammerly (published by The Mountaineers, Seattle).
